CLASS/PROGRAM VOLUNTEER

Responsibilities:

- Provides general class support (prep materials, class set-up, assist during classes, class clean-up)
- Early Childhood experience preferred, but not required
- Desire to work with young children (ages 0-8) is essential
- Minimum 6-month commitment
- Weekday shifts only
- **Ages 18 and up**

PROGRAM PREP VOLUNTEER

Responsibilities:

- Preps materials for classes and public programs
- Previous art experience desired, but not necessary
- Must be able to assemble multi-step projects and cut out intricate shapes; strong motor skills necessary
- Weekday and Sunday shifts available
- Minimum 6-month commitment
- **Ages 16 and up**

FESTIVAL VOLUNTEER

Responsibilities:

- Provides additional support at festivals throughout the year (includes set-up, assisting with activities, and break-down)
- Desire to work with young children (ages 0-8) is essential
- Must be able to stand for an extended period of time and lift up to approximately 30lbs.
- Weekend & weekday shifts available depending on festival date
- Must provide own transportation to and from festivals
- **Ages 16 and up**

Team Play Guide Volunteers—Team Play Guide Volunteers are the heartbeat of the Zimmer! They assist our Play Guide staff with just about everything around the museum. From restoring exhibits, to playing with the little ones, Play Guide volunteers know how to throw a party!

Responsibilities:

- Museum Floor Support (restoring exhibits, encouraging play w/ families, assisting w/ the facilitation of Public Programs)
- May also assist in Public Programs

- Must be comfortable standing for an extended period of time
- Minimum 6-month commitment
- Weekdays and Sundays shifts available
- **Ages 16 and up**

Team Visitor Services Volunteers—Team Visitor Services Volunteers assist the Front Desk and Visitor Services staff to make sure that all of our guests and families are up-to-date with all of the super fun stuff going on at the Zimmer! From greeting families as they enter the museum, to providing information about classes and programs, Team Visitor Services volunteers are an outgoing bunch!

Responsibilities:

- Visitor Experience Support (Greeting guests, providing additional front desk phone support, escorting guests to the downstairs level of museum, assisting with survey distribution and collection)
- Minimum 6-month commitment
- Weekdays and Sundays shifts available
- **Ages 17 and up**
